
4. What are the prominent portions in the prayer of Mor Severious?

St Jacob gained deep knowledge in the faith and history of the church and in Greek and Syriac languages. He lived by learning the scriptures and prayers and by fasting as a monk. He distributed whole of his wealth to the poor and freed the slaves after the death of his parents. He lived with only one set of dress to wear. Even that dress was torn and appeared as leather so he was called as Burdono (leather wearer)

- 4 Write about the New Testament Priesthood?

Jesus Christ entrusted the apostles to continue the New Testament sacrifice until his second coming. They performed and entrusted to their successors. The New Testament priesthood is the fulfillment of the Old Testament priesthood and the succession of priesthood in Jesus Christ.
