1. What are the main thoughts in the prophecy of Daniel?

**ANS.** Chapters 1-6: These chapters emphasize <u>unshakable trust in God</u> and adherence to <u>traditional Jewish rituals</u>, as demonstrated by Daniel and his friends (Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego). I mark

Chapters 7-12: These chapters focus on Daniel's visions, which reveal that <u>all colonialist</u> powers against God and His plans will be destroyed, and the kingdom of God will ultimately <u>survive</u>. 1 mark

2. In what way is the book of Jonah a suitable response, and to what question or situation?

**ANS**. The book of Jonah is an apt reply to <u>the narrow-minded belief that salvation is the right of</u> *Jews alone.* (1 mark)

It conveys that <u>God's mercy has no boundaries and that all people are God's children,</u> <u>deserving of salvation. (1 mark)</u>

3. What were the additional authority, duties, and promises Jesus gave his disciples in Galilee? (0.5 marks for each point)

ANS: The additional powers, duties, and promises that the disciples were granted were:

- a. **Powers**: Make disciples of all nations.
- b. **Duties:** Baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
- c. **Teach** them to obey the commandments of Jesus.
- d. **Promise:** The great promise that Jesus gave to the Apostles was, "I am with you always, to the end of the age."
- 4. What is the significance of the first and the second circumambulation on Good Friday? (1 mark for each point)

**ANS.** The first circumambulation <u>symbolizes Jesus' journey to Golgotha carrying the cross</u>. It is conducted after the 3rd-hour prayers and involves a specific route around the church.

The <u>second circumambulation</u> is conducted towards the end of the service, <u>after the cross</u> <u>adoration</u>. It <u>symbolizes the carrying of Jesus' body for burial by Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus.</u>

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5. Write down the two charges imposed against Jesus by Jews other than blasphemy? (1 mark for each point)

**ANS.** The two charges brought against Jesus by the Jews, apart from blasphemy, were:

- a. Jesus taught people not to pay taxes to Caesar, the Roman Emperor.
- b. Jesus claimed to be a king, which was seen as a challenge to Roman authority

#### 1. What are the main thoughts of Ezekiel's prophesy?

The main Thoughts of Ezekiel's prophesies are:

- Part 1 (Chapters 1-33): Punishment (2 marks)
- a. Exposes infidelity and sins of Judah and Jerusalem.
- b. Severe punishments are inevitable.
- c. Judgment day is imminent.
- d. Nations oppressing Israel will also be punished.
- Part 2 (Chapters 34-38): Deliverance (2 marks) (any 4 points)
- a. God will care for, seek, and rescue His sheep.
- b. Injured will be healed.
- c. Hope for Israel's reinstatement after enemy destruction.
- d. Desolate cities will be repopulated.
- e. Safety, prosperity, and renewed hearts for the people.
- f. New temple as a source of living water.
- Application to Social Order and Individuals (1 mark)
- a. Punishment and salvation apply to both Israel as a whole and individuals.
- b. Each person is judged by their own deeds.

## 2. <u>How many times did the resurrected Jesus appear to His disciples and others according to the Holy Bible, and who were the individuals or groups He appeared to?</u>

It is recorded in the Holy Bible that the resurrected Jesus had appeared 10 times to his disciples and others. (0.5 mark for each point)

- 1. To Mary Magdalene alone, near the tomb. St. John 20:11-18
- 2. To Mary Magdalene and the other Mary St. Matthew 28:1-10
- 3. To St. Peter alone St. Luke 24:34, 1 Corinthians 15:5
- 4. To the two disciples who were going to Emmaus St. Luke 24: 13-35
- 5. To the 10 disciples except St. Thomas on the same day of Resurrection in the evening at the Mansion of Mark. St. John 20:19-24
- 6. To the 11 disciples including St. Thomas on the 8th day of the Resurrection at the Mansion of Mark St. Mark 16:14-18.
- 7. To the disciples at the shore of the Sea of Tiberias St. John 21: 1-23

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- 8. To the 11 disciples and 500 other brothers and sisters in Galilee St. Matthew, 28:16-20, 1 Corinthians 15:6
- 9. To St. James 1 Cor. 15:7
- 10. To all those who had gathered at the time of His Ascension St.Mark 16:19, St.Luke 24:50-52

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3. Explain the celebration of the Passover Feast and the institution of the Holy Qurbana (1 mark for each point)

Five Main Points on How Jesus Instituted the Holy Qurbana

- a. Jesus instructed Peter and John to prepare for the Passover Feast at the Mansion of Mark, following the requirements of the Law (Exodus 12).1.25 mark
- b. Jesus and His disciples took the Passover meal as prescribed. During the meal, Jesus revealed Judas's impending betrayal, prompting Judas to leave. 1.25 mark
- c. During the feast, the disciples debated about who among them was the greatest. Jesus illustrated the model of humility and service by washing their feet. 1.25 mark
- d. After completing the observance of the Passover feast according to the Law, Jesus instituted the Holy Qurbana, 1.25 mark (signifying His body and blood, offering it as a covenant of salvation and the foundation for the sacrament of the Eucharist)

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- 4. Describe the contributions of St James to the Church through his writings. (1 mark each)
  - a. St. James, known as the "flute of the Holy Spirit," enriched church prayers with his poems and supplications. (1 mark)
  - **b.** He wrote **760 prayer-poems**, copied by **70 scribes**. (1mark)
  - c. He authored many practical moral letters. (0.75 mark)
  - d. His poetic works cover Old Testament figures, angels, the mysteries of the Son of God, festival lessons, sermons, funeral orations, hymns, and more. (1.25 mark)
  - e. He also wrote two books on Baptism rites and Mor Daniel and Mor Hananya biographies. (1mark)

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
