V. SHORT ANSWERS

 $(5 \times 1.5 = 7.5 \text{ marks})$

1) How did Peter heal the lame?

Answer:

- a. Peter healed the lame man by proclaiming, "I have no silver or Gold but I have I give you, In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, stand up and walk." (0.75)
- b. Peter extended his hand and helped the man to rise, and immediately the man gained strength, stood up, and began to walk. (0.5)
- c. Then he entered the temple with them praising God (0.25)

2) Why did the Apostles Peter and John visit the Samaritans, and what happened when they laid their hands on those who were baptized?

Answer:

- a. Upon learning that the Samaritans had accepted the Word of God, the Apostles in Jerusalem sent Peter and John to visit them. (0.75)
- b. Upon their arrival, Peter and John prayed for the baptized individuals and laid their hands on them, resulting in their receiving the Holy Spirit. (0.5)
- c. Until that moment, they had only been baptized in the name of God. (0.25)
- 3) What are the gifts of blessings received by "The Holy Matrimony?"

Answer:

- a. People attain the gifts of blessing for constituting a Christian family by standing close to Jesus Christ (0.75)
- b. The blessing for the propagation of family from this sacrament. (0.75)

4) What are the three positions of Priesthood?

Answer:

The three important positions of Priesthood are:

- a. Deacon (0.5), Priest (0.5) Episcopa (0.5).
- 5) What advice does St. James give regarding the anointing of oil for the sick?

(if the full verse from the Bible James 5:14 is not written, the full mark should not be given)

Answer:

Apostolic advice regarding the anointing of oil, St. James, the apostle says, "Are any among you sick? "They should call for the elders of the church and have them pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord "(1.5 marks).

VI. SHORT NOTES

(Answer any TWO) (2 x 2.5 = 5marks)

- 1) What were the incidents that led to the oath at the Bent Cross?.

 Answer:
 - a. Mor Ahatulla Bava, who sought to **protect his church from the oppressive Roman yoke**, was arrested at **Mylapore and brought to Kochi Fort,** bound and **handcuffed**, for **transportation to Goa**. (Arrest of Mor Ahatulla Bava)(0.5)
 - b. The news of **Ahatulla Bava's murder by drowning in the sea quickly spread**, causing immense **grief and anger among the Syrians**. (News of His Death) (0.5)
 - c. In response to the tragic news, the **Syrians assembled at Mattancherry**, **united** in **their sorrow and outrage**.(*Gathering at Mattancherry*)(0.5)
 - d. They tied a **rope to a stone cross present at the site and swore an oath** that they would **never again accept the Roman Church** or the **Jesuit Bishop responsible for the death of their leader**. This oath was made on **Friday, the 3rd of Makarom**, **1653**.(*Oath of Rejection* (0.5)
 - e. As thousands of **faithful held tightly to the rope tied to the cross**, it bent under the weight, and **this cross came to be known as the Bent Cross**(*The Bent Cross*)(0.5)

From that day onward this declaration is known as Oath at the Bent Cross

2) What roles had significance for Prophet Samuel in Israel's history?

- a. Samuel is known as **a Judges in Israel** who **administered justice and saved the Israelites** from their enemies (0.5)
- b. Samuel was not only a judge but also **a prophet**, making him a <u>significant spiritual</u> figure in Israel with the Lord's presence with him (0.5)

- c. The entire nation of Israel, from Dan to Beersheba, recognized Samuel as a faithful prophet of the Lord. (0.5)
- d. Samuel **anointed Saul and David**, the first two kings of Israel, (0.5)
- e. As a prophet, **Samuel helped the kings in matters of administration** and **judgment** and **rebuked** them when necessary on some occasions to uphold God's will (0.5)

3) Why does Simon the sorcerer pray for the intercession of the Apostles?

Answer:

- a. When Simon saw that the **Holy Spirit was conferred on the people by laying hands** on them by the Apostles (0.5),
- b. Simon the Sorcerer requested that he might also be given this power and that the Apostles would be given money for that (0.5).
- c. To this Peter answered "May your silver perish with you, because you thought you could obtain God's gift with money! (0.5)
- d. Repent therefore of this wickedness of yours, and pray to the Lord that, if possible, the intent of your heart may be forgiven you" Simon said in reply to this." Pray for me to the Lord, that nothing of what youhave said may happen to me. (1)

4) What were some of the notable names and position given to St. Paulose Mor Athanasius Metropolitan, and what were his special qualities?

- a. The late St. Paulose Mor Athanasius Metropolitan, known as the "**Protector of Faith**" and "**Valiyathirumeni**" of Alwaye, .(1 mark)
- b. Thirumeni served as the **Malankara Metropolitan** and **addressed church challenges** through **prayer and fasting (0.5)**
- c. His **punctuality in prayer**, **zeal for faith**, and **prayers of repentance** are exemplary qualities that all the faithful should strive to follow. (0.75) (note: should be there in the answer)
- d. The Holy Father **lived humbly in a hut** built in the courtyard of his house. (0.25)
