2. State the difference in the prayer of the Pharisee and the tax Collector?
- The Pharisee justified himself and blamed the tax collector. The Pharisee is not trying to pray but trying to inform God how much just he is. (1.25 marks)
  - The tax collector stands far off with the humble thought that he is not fit enough even to raise his eyes to heaven. He confesses that he is a sinner. His prayer reaches God because of these reasons. (1.25 marks)
  - The Pharisee who justifies himself and the tax collector who repents and prays.
3. State ANY 5 of the Ten Commandments (0.5 marks for each)
- I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery; you shall have no other gods before me. .
  - You shall not make for yourself an idol, whether in the form of anything that is in heaven above, or that is on the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. You shall not bow down to them or worship them
  - You shall not make wrongful use of the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not acquit anyone who misuses his name.
  - Remember the sabbath day, and keep it holy.
  - Honour your father and your mother, so that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.
  - You shall not murder.
  - You shall not commit adultery.
  - You shall not steal.
  - You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour.

- **Holy Baptism-** The death of our old life and birth into the heavenly life is occurring through the Baptism.
- **Holy Mooron-** This is the mark of the anointment of the Holy Spirit. It is the perfume and Fragrance of the Messiah and the sign and seal of accomplishments.
- **Holy Priesthood-** This is a Sacrament instituted by God. Only those who have obtained priest hood have the authority to perform other Sacraments.
