Ans: The feeding of 5000 people (0.5) with 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish (0.5) is the only miracle (0.5) recorded in all four Gospels. (1.5 marks)

2. What does the Lord mean by 'Become like children' and write its specialties?

Ans: Become like children means cultivating a **childlike nature** marked by **the innocence** in our life (0.5)

- Humility and Sympathy (0.25)
- Life devoid of worries and anxieties (0.25)
- Purity of mind and complete faith in parents (0.5)
- 3. Why is Sacraments called mystery?
- Sacraments are a mystery because they **bring inner**, **spiritual blessings to the faithful.** (0.5)
- The **faithful experience** (through a matter) is **beyond human intelligence**. (0.5)
- The spiritual nature of sacraments is conveyed through unexplainable and invisible matter (0.5)
- 4. What are the Holy Sacraments which is received only once? (1.5 marks)

Ans: Holy Baptism (0.5) Holy Moroon (0.5) Holy Priesthood (0.5)

- 1. How can we classify the Old Testament based on its contents? (In POINTS)
- 2. What can we learn from the miracle performed by Jesus, as recorded by St. Mark (6:37), in the lesson "Jesus Takes Care of the Hungry?
- 3. Who instituted Holy Baptism and what are some important aspects of Holy Baptism?

ANSWER 1 The Old Testament can be classified under contents of -

- a. The period of Genesis to selection of Abraham consists of Genesis 1 to 11. (0.5 marks)
- b. The **history of forefathers** starting from the *selection of Abraham* **till the Israelites reached Egypt**. This portion consists of chapters **12 to 50 of Genesis**. (0.5 marks)
- c. The history of **liberation from Egypt**, till the **Israelites reach the gate of Cannan, the promised land.** This includes the books from **Exodus and Deuteronomy**. (0.5 marks)
- d. The period from the capture of Cannan by the Israelites under the leadership of Joshua till their captivity in Babylon. Consists of books from Joshua to II Chronicles. (0.5 marks)
- e. The period of **return from captivity** till the time just **before the birth of Jesus Christ**. These are the remaining books of the Old Testament. (0.5 marks)

ANSWER 2 - The miracle performed by Jesus, as recorded by St. Mark (6:37), in the lesson "Jesus Takes Care of the Hungry

- a. The disciples initially made worldly calculations without remembering God's presence. (0.5)
- **b.** Jesus showed that with God, **nothing is impossible.** (0.5)
- c. Jesus asked, "Bring them here to me," emphasizing trust and submission. (0.5)
- d. The boy's willingness to submit what he had led to a great miracle. (0.5)
- e. When we submit our possessions, such as wealth, knowledge, and health, to God, He can use them for the benefit of both us and society. (0.5)

ANSWER 3: Holy Baptism and Important aspects of Holy Baptism

- a) Holy Baptism was **instituted by Lord Jesus Christ** (0.5)
- b) Holy baptism was instituted **before his Ascension** (St. Mathew 28:18-19). (0.5)
- c) This Sacrament came into practice on the day of Pentecost (Act 1:37-39) (0.5)
- d) The **demise of our old life** and the **birth into the heavenly life** occurs through Holy Baptism. (0.5)
- e) Through Holy Baptism gifts of **blessings like rebirth**, **justification**, and **acceptance as Son are received** (0.5)
