1. Which bible portion is known as song of Moses? What is the circumstance for writing this song?

Deuteronomy chapter 32 is known as song of Moses. (0.5 marks)

God gave warning to the Israelites through Moses that <u>on reaching</u> the land through which honey and milk flow, <u>if they forget the true God and worship any of the other Gods, they will perish.</u> Moses wrote this song <u>in testimony</u> of this and kept it safely in the ark in the tent. (1.5 marks)

- 2. Why St. James is being called as "Holy man"? (1 mark for each point)
  - St. James was sanctified in the womb itself and set apart.
  - He kept away from wine and flesh, remained unshaved and firm in observances. So, he was called a "Holy man".
  - 3. What was the right of Levites on the land and how many cities did they get? (2 marks)

    When the land of Canaan was divided, Levi was not given any right. But in
    the rights of their brothers, there were provisions for Levites to have cities
    to live in and pastures for their cattle and animal possessions. In total
    Levites got 48 cities and pastures in the rights of the children of Israel.
    - 4. What does the Lord teach through the parable of mustard seed? (2 marks)
      - The parable of mustard seed indicates the amazing growth of the Kingdom of God. The beginning of the Kingdom of God was small. It begins in Jesus. When it attains the fullness, the Kingdom will be the meeting place of all races.



5. What are the gifts of virtues received by confession? (2 marks)

The gifts of virtues received by confession are <u>absolution of sin</u>, <u>truce with</u> <u>God</u> and <u>acceptance</u> as children of God.

VII. SHORT ANSWERS

(Answer any TWO in 3 or more sentences)

 $(2 \times 2.5 = 5 marks)$ 

- 1. Who are the four types of people indicating in the parable of Sower?

  Different kinds of soil are the different kinds of people and seeds are God's messages. Jesus points out four types of people. (0.5 marks for each point)
  - Those who don't understand the message they hear: Similar to that fell along the path.
  - Those who abandon the messages when difficulties arise: Similar to the seed fell on rocky ground.
  - Some hear the message but because of the worldly thoughts the message does not grow in them, they are like the seeds that fell on the thorny bushes.
  - Those who hear and understand the message and live accordingly, doing charity for others are similar to the seeds that fell on the good soil.
  - 2. What are the preparations needed for receiving Holy Qurbana?
    - (0.5 mark for each point)
    - Those who receive Holy Qurbana should receive it with <u>prayer</u>, <u>devotion and faith</u> after true confession of the sins.
    - We should receive the Holy Qurbana, with <u>proper fasting and with</u> <u>necessary preparation</u>. But in the case of the bed ridden, fasting is not compulsory.
    - Once the confession is made, confession is not compulsory for receiving the Holy Qurbana for the next forty days.
    - Holy Qurbana can be received after having *Hoosoyo* prayer from the priest (prayer for redemption from sin).

- But if the receiver is convinced of having <u>fallen in any sin during the</u> <u>period of 40 days, he/she should receive the Holy Qurbana only after making confession.</u>
- 3. How are the tribes of Israel being divided? (0.5 mark for each point)
  - The division of the land was done by the priest Eleazar, Joshua son of Nun and heads of the families of tribes. The division of land was by drawing lots as commanded by the Lord through Moses.
  - Joshua divided the land for nine and half of the tribes.
  - At the eastern bank of Jordan Moses had divided and assigned land for two and half tribes.
  - The tribes are known in the names of 12 sons of Jacob. But <u>among the twelve sons Levi alone had not been assigned share in the land of Canaan.</u>
  - But in the place of Joseph his sons Manessa and Ephraim were taken into account. Joseph did not get separate share for himself as two sons were included. That is how the 12 tribes are completed.
- 4. Write down the lessons we understand from the miraculous healing of the daughter of the Canaanite women? (0.5 mark for each point)
  - The gentile woman identifies Jesus as the Son of David
  - Even though reply has not been given, she requests again and again without being desperate
  - The disciples intercede on behalf of her.
  - Jesus verifies her faith. She has a humble nature to stoop herself unto the place of a dog.
  - She is firm in her faith without disappointment or agony even when she hears Him refer to her people as dogs. Here it is evident that the prayer to the Lord will result in the of cure to her daughter. The Lord appreciates her firm faith.
